This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, what cookies Khidma.live uses, and how you can control them.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help the website remember information about your visit — for example, your preferences or whether you have visited before. Cookies cannot harm your device and do not contain personally identifiable information on their own.

2. What Cookies We Use

We use the following categories of cookies on khidma.live:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the website to function. They cannot be switched off. They are set in response to actions you take such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in, or filling in forms.

Analytical / Performance Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors use our website so we can improve it. All data collected is aggregated and anonymous.

| _ga | Google Analytics | Tracks page visits and user behaviour | 2 years |
| _gid | Google Analytics | Distinguishes users | 24 hours |

Functional Cookies

These cookies enable enhanced functionality, such as remembering your region or language preference.

| Cookie | Purpose | Duration |
|-------------|---|----------|
| region_pref | Remembers your selected region (UK/UAE/USA) | 30 days |

We do **not** use advertising or tracking cookies. We do not share cookie data with third parties for marketing purposes.

3. Third-Party Cookies
